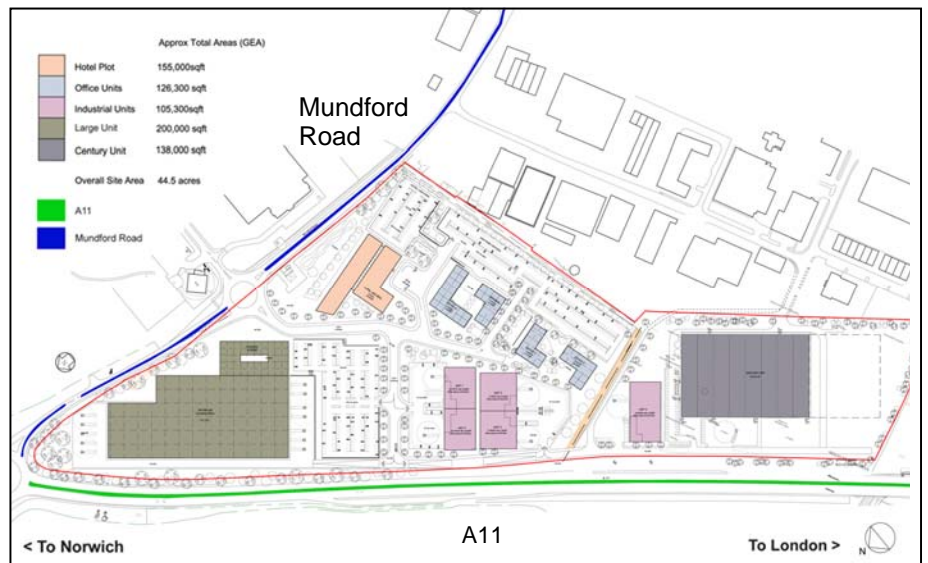
Thetford Enterprise Park offers a new high quality business park in a growing innovative area

What...

The Thetford Enterprise Park (TEP) is part of a £6.5 million project within Breckland's Rural Enterprise Valley (REV) project that seeks to support advanced engineering and motor sport businesses along the A11 corridor from Thetford to Attleborough.

The 44 acre high quality business park will have regional significance and is a unique joint venture between Breckland Council and The Crown Estate with funding support from the East of England Development Agency (EEDA). TEP will help address current and future infrastructure and job requirements forecasted to 2021. The funding will contribute to the substantial infrastructure works to open the site for occupation.

TEP will have sustainability and low carbon principles embedded into its DNA and will kick start the development of Thetford and the A11 corridor and be the business gateway to Norfolk.

The TEP project development timetable is:

- September 08 - TEP Launch to celebrate funding agreement
- September 08 - TEP marketing begins
- Mid 2009 – Construction of Mundford Road roundabout
- Beginning 2010 – Construction for on site infrastructure
- Mid 2010 – Occupation on site
